Money Go Round – Save or Spend

Instructions:

- 1.) Give one participant at each table \$110 in play money (eleven \$10 bills).
- 2.) Allow each participant to save or spend \$10 from the list of questions. If they choose to spend they must place a \$10 bill in the middle of the table. Then hand the remaining money to the participant on their right.
- 3.) Play continues around the table until all of the questions have been answered.

You're getting ready to leave the house for work. Would you rather spend \$5 and pick up coffee from Starbucks or save \$5 and fill a thermos at home?

It's Friday night. Would you rather spend \$50 and take the family to the movies or save \$48 and rent videos from Redbox or save \$50 and Netflix and chill?

You need some new workout clothes. Would you rather spend \$30 on a dope brand name T-shirt or save \$25 and buy a no name T-shirt?

The holiday season is upon us. Would you rather spend \$50 and buy a gift for a friend or save \$40 and make them a gift instead?

It's lunchtime and you and some coworkers want to go out to lunch. Would you rather spend \$3 and withdraw cash from an ATM that is not operated by your bank or save \$3 and drive three miles out of your way to make a withdrawal from an ATM operated by your bank?

It's a blistering hot day in mid-July. Would you rather spend \$6 and go swimming at the city pool or save \$6 and go swimming in the ditch out by the corral?

Your favorite music group just released a track. Would you rather spend \$10 and buy it on Spotify or save \$10 and download it on from your family?

You are stranded in Eagle Butte, South Dakota during a blizzard. Would you rather spend \$60 and rent a motel room for the night or save \$60 and sleep in your car?

Your car is running on empty. Would you rather spend an extra \$10 and fill up with premium unleaded gasoline or save \$10 and fill up with regular no-leaded?

You're ordering dinner at Chipotle. Would you rather spend \$2 and drink a soda or save \$2 and drink water?

It's your anniversary. Would you rather spend \$100 and take your babe out to a nice restaurant or save \$75 and prepare a nice dinner at home?
