History

Our Business

- Wells Fargo has a legacy of serving Native American and Alaska Native communities for more than 65 years.
- Wells Fargo serves this community through 87 branches on or near tribal lands in 12 states.
- Wells Fargo has banking relationships with 1 out of 3 federally recognized tribes in the U.S. We have committed \$3.4 billion in credit and hold \$4.1 billion in deposits for tribal governments and tribally owned enterprises nationally.

Philanthropy

- In 2018, Wells Fargo committed \$50 million of philanthropic support. The commitment has been fulfilled.
- In 2023, the company launched Invest Native, a \$20 million placebased philanthropic initiative in six states.



Invest Native Overview

Invest Native is a \$20 million philanthropic effort to support Native-led nonprofit organizations and the communities they serve in New Mexico, Arizona, Montana, Wyoming, North Dakota, and South Dakota.







Place

People who are closest to problems solve problems

- Leverages existing collaborations in key geographies
- Makes investments in regional efforts and bridges gap between local and national support

Scale

Increase capacity of organizations to serve more customers

- Invests in technology, systems and processes so organizations can meet customer demand
- Prepares organizations to attract and receive government and foundation support

Equity

Supports Native American leaders

- Organizations are Native-Led and most are led by women.
- Native-Led nonprofits receive .04% of U.S. philanthropic

- Predevelopment costs for housing projects
- Home loans/down payment assistance programs
- Native financial housing counseling



Small Business Growth

- Microloan & access to capital programs
- Technical assistance to Native small business
- Business and accelerator programs



Financial Health

- Development of financial education curriculum
- Pilot IDA program
- Credit counseling



Sustainability and Climate Resilience

- Solar energy for Native homes
- Infrastructure to support climate resiliency in tribal lands





- New CRA guidelines will provide more weight for activities in Tribal lands.
- Shared program with Department of Commerce, Department of Interior



Invest Native – CDFIs

- Invest Native CDFI Funding in 2023
 - 7 CDFIs
 - − ~\$4 million
- Several strong LOIs in Round 2 (2024)
- Partnership with Native CDFI Network (NCN) to cultivate opportunity in California & Nevada
- Strong alignment with Community Lending & Investment team to identify patient capital opportunities
- Exploring other targeted support for CDFIs
