
#### **Definitions**

- **Resilience**: the capacity of individuals, communities, institutions, businesses, and systems to survive, adapt, and **THRIVE** no matter what kinds of chronic stresses and acute shocks they experience.
- Acute Shock: sudden, sharp events that harm individuals, buildings, businesses, organizations, natural ecosystems and weaken the fabric of a community or larger human or nature-based system.
- Chronic Stress: slow moving, existing impacts that burden individuals, buildings, businesses, organizations, natural ecosystems and weaken the fabric of a community or nature-based system on a day-today or cyclical basis.

**Importantly**, shocks and stresses are overlapping and interconnected, and the intersection of shocks and stresses often creates cascading effects, potentially leading to additional shocks and stresses. Climate change is a **stress**, but it is an overarching one, exacerbating existing stresses and colliding shocks.


