Facts:


There are 557 federally recognized tribes in the U.S. 226 of these tribes are located in Alaska

The American Indian & Alaska Native population totals 2.3 million

Between 1887 and 1934, the U.S. government took over 90 million acres of land from tribes without compensation.

The largest reservation in the U.S. is the Navajo Nation.

The smallest reservation is less than one acre.

Federal Policy Era's on Native Peoples

A Great Democracy Built on Native Lands It's Always Been a Question of <u>What To Do with Natives</u> From <u>Policy of Manifest Destiny</u> to <u>Self Governance</u>

Contact – 1828: Discovery/Extermination Era

- **1828 1887:** Treaty Era (Forced Removal to Reservations & Trust Lands)
- 1887 1934: Assimilation Era (Boarding Schools, Allotments, Citizenship)
- **1934 1945:** Self Governance Era (Federal Recognition)
- **1945 1965**: Repeat. Assimilation/Termination/Urbanization

1965 – Present: Self Determination/Self Governance

- You Say....Reservations. We Say Hawaiian Home Lands or Homesteads
- Congress Set-Aside 203,000 Acres for our Tribal Land Trust

• Self Governance on Trust Lands.....

• You Say.....Tribal Govts. We Say Homestead Beneficiary Associations (HBAs)

Blood Quantum.....

- Your Tribal Govts.....Get to Set Yours. We Are Stuck with Congress Setting Ours
- For our Tribal Lands,,,,Enrollment its a 50% Blood Quantum w/ 25% Heirship
- For All Other Programs Its Descendancy....like NACA, Health, Education

- Same Bully Aloha.....

• Enrolled & Unenrolled....

- You Say......Tribal Citizens or Members. We Say Homesteader/Waitlister/Beneficiary
- We All.....Serve our People Regardless of Enrollment, Especially NCDFIs!

• Sovereignty.....

- You Say....Sovereignty. We Say Sovereignty. Its All Community Development.
- You Have Part 83 if You Want Federal Recognition.....We Have Part 50 if We Do.

Our Hawaiian Home Lands – Tribal Lands

• 203,000+ Acres on 6 Islands and 4 Counties

- Largest Concentration on Hawaii Island
- 10,000 Lessees all Islands After 100 Years of Administration (avg 100 Lots per yr)
- 29,000 on a Waitlist all Islands (avg age is nearly 60 years old!)
- Enacted in 1920 Same Policy Era as Other Native Allotment Acts

re. Abunda

- To receive land allotments for Homes, for Farms, for Ranches
- To receive land allotments for mercantile business and commerce
- Homestead Associations (self governance)
 - 50 Individual Homestead Associations!
 - 2 Statewide Homestead Associations (SCHHA & AHHL)


